<u>Camper Photos:</u> Butman Methodist Camp will be posting pictures to our **FACEBOOK** page daily. Just click on your camps photo album to view camper's pictures taken during camp activities. Parents/Guardians may opt out of pictures of their camper(s); this will need to be expressed to the camp director at check-in registration.

What To Bring: bedroll, blanket, pillow, towel, washcloth, soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, bible, pen & paper, Modest swimsuit (girls-one piece please!) or a t-shirt cover-up, sunscreen, flashlight & extra batteries, appropriate sleep wear, mosquito repellent, 12-pack of water or a reusable water container, suitable outdoor clothing - warm days/cool nights (put your name on your gear), spending money for snacks and T-shirts (see enclosed sheet for Camp Store items and prices). <u>Do Not Bring</u>: Cell Phones, fireworks, roller blades, stereos, CD Players, MP3 Players, or other electronic devices.

Medical Exclusions

An ill child cannot be accepted for a camping event. If on the day of camp one or more of the following exist, please do not bring your child to camp.

- The illness prevents the child from participating comfortably in camping activities.
- The illness results in a greater need for care than the staff can provide without compromising the health, safety, and supervision of the other campers.
- The child has any of the following:
 - Oral temperature of 100 F or higher; Rectal temperature of 101 F or higher; Armpit temperature 99 F or higher
 - AND has behavioral changes or other signs and symptoms of illness until medical evaluation indicates that the child can be included in camping activities OR
 - Symptoms and signs of severe illness, such as:
 - Lethargy
 - o H1N1 Virus
 - Difficulty breathing
 - Uncontrolled Diarrhea (2 or more loose, watery stools in 24 hours)
 - Vomiting illness (2 or more episodes in 24 hours)
 - o Rash with fever
 - Mouth sores with drooling
 - Head lice
 - Wheezing
 - Behavior change or other unusual signs
 UNTIL medical evaluation indicates that the child can be included in camping activities, Or
 - The child has been diagnosed with a communicable disease, UNTIL
 medical evaluation indicates that the child is no longer contagious and is
 able to be included in camping activities.
